This week is an opportunity to introduce team members to careers in the digital technology world and beyond. Invite a guest speaker or a panel of guest speakers to speak about their careers and how they relate to cyber safety.

Objectives

- Learn about the role technology plays in one or more career fields.
- Continue planning for Cyber Safety Awareness Week.

Materials

- PowerPoint presentations, handouts, or other material the speaker wants to provide
- A small thank you note or card from the team

Agenda

Invite a guest or panel of guest speakers with experience in some aspect of cyber safety to attend your meeting. The meeting agenda can be adapted to meet your team's needs. It can be as formal or informal as you like. Make sure to leave time for team members to connect with speakers and ask questions about their presentation.

Discussion Points

- What kind of education is required for a job involving cyber safety?
- How does the pace of technological changes affect jobs in cyber safety?
- What can Team Cyber SWAT members do to prepare now for future careers in cyber safety?

Things to consider

- Consider inviting speakers from a variety of professional backgrounds. These could include but are not limited to:
 - Counseling/mental health
 - Social media marketing
 - Cybersecurity
 - Law enforcement/intelligence
 - Education
 - o Journalism
- Teams may want to invite students to submit questions ahead of this meeting, either in person or via the team's Cyber S.W.A.T. social media accounts.
- This week may also be a good time for team members to invite friends who are not regularly involved. You can use this meeting to generate interest in the upcoming year's Cyber S.W.A.T. program.
- When choosing who to invite, you may want to consider people from careers in which some of your members have shown interest.

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
